RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SPAY, NEUTER, AND/OR DECLAWING

This estimate/information is provided for your convenience only. This is only an estimate of services. Treatment may be altered to better fit each individual cat/kitten's needs. If you have any questions during or before an appointment about additional costs, we are happy to provide further information. Each surgical procedure listed includes the procedure(s), anesthetic, overnight visit (if required), pain medication, and follow-up appointment. Your cat must be current on its Feline Distemper Vaccination and have a current Physical Exam prior to surgery. You will be asked to hold your pet off food/water the night before surgery, and drop off your pet between 7:30 and 9:00 am the morning of surgery. There is paperwork to fill out paperwork that morning and your cat will be checked in by the doctor. Please allow adequate time when dropping off.

Spaying and Neutering Recommendations

Male Cats – Neuter at 4-6 months
Female Cats – Spay at 6 months

Declawing Procedures

Declawing at the time of Spay or Neuter

When possible, we recommend declawing your cat at the time of its spay or neuter procedure. This will mean your cat only has to go under anesthetic one time for both procedures and will have one recovery period versus two. Recovery time is usually 10-14 days. If your cat is declawed, you will need to use special litter until your cat's paws have been rechecked. The alternative to special litter is shredded newspaper. Do not use regular litter after your cat has been declawed until the doctor gives you the okay to switch back.

Additional Recommendations

Presurgical Blood work (<i>Kidney and Liver Functions</i>) and an EKG <i>(Presurgical Blood work is an optional service. It is recommended to give us a better view "inside" your cat prior to anesthetizing him/her to predict any potential problems that may come up during a surgical procedure. This will help minimize the risks of anesthetic. This service is recommended with any anesthetic procedure.)</i>	\$45.00
